Siltbuster joins AMEC's Pavement Team at Gatwick Airport

The pavement team framework agreement is a 5 year partnering agreement between BAA plc and AMEC Civil Engineering Ltd to deliver aircraft pavements and ancillary works at Heathrow, Gatwick, Stansted and Southampton.

The team is involved in conceptual and feasibility studies; detailed design; construction and commissioning.

It is also responsible for Project Managing and ensuring the quality of work.

The pavement team purchased it's first *Siltbuster* unit in July 2003 as part of a contract to construct new power supply and distribution facilities for the aircraft stands and aprons.
